

DIRECTIONS TO BETHEL PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

Welcome to Bethel Presbyterian Church! While here, we hope you'll feel at home in our historic sanctuary, stroll through the old walled cemetery, and enjoy Bethel's outstanding barbecue. Bethel is located in McLeansville, halfway between Greensboro and Burlington, at the intersection of Knox Road and Bethel Church Road, one-half mile north of Rt. 70 and the Greensboro water tower.

FROM THE EAST: Take I-40/I-85 west toward Greensboro, to exit 132, Mt. Hope Church Road. At the top of the ramp, turn right. Beside the Hess/Wilco gas station at the interchange, turn right onto Knox Road. At the stoplight at Rt. 70, continue straight another half mile. Bethel is on the left.

FROM THE WEST: Take I-40 east past Greensboro - both bypass I-40 and business I-40 will bring you to Bethel. Right after the bypass and business routes re-converge, look for exit 132, Mt. Hope Church Road. At the top of the ramp, turn left onto Mt. Hope Church Road. Beside the Hess/Wilco gas station, turn right onto Knox Road. At the stoplight at Rt. 70, continue straight another half mile. Bethel will be ahead of you on the left.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take I-85 north bypass until it converges with business I-85. Stay right and look for exit 132, Mt. Hope Church Road. At the top of the ramp, turn left onto Mt. Hope Church Road. Beside the Hess/Wilco gas station, turn right onto Knox Road. At the stoplight at Rt. 70, continue straight another half mile. Bethel will be ahead of you on the left.

FROM THE NORTH: Go to the Rt. 29/Rt. 150 intersection. Turn south - at first you might think it is the Rt. 29 exit ramp! - onto McLeansville Road. In McLeansville, immediately after you cross the railroad tracks, turn left onto Bethel Church Road. At the stop sign, turn left onto Knox Road; the church is on your left.
